



The Indiana Assembly Affirmation of Purpose and Conduct

I affirm that I am not a member of any Law Enforcement Agency or Public Agency of the Federal, State, City, County or Township Agency. I will not promote violence of any kind nor act as an insurrectionist or enemy combatant.

I affirm that I will conduct myself with honor, respect, peace and love as I self-govern. I will treat my fellow Living Men and Women in the same manner as I conduct myself. I will leave my ego at the door, because the Assembly has important work to do, and bringing an ego to the table, serves no one, and only causes harm with so much at stake.

I affirm that I have studied the paperwork process and have full knowledge that each Assembly member has autographed their name and sealed their own documents to affirm their status and rebut any Corporate presumptions.

I affirm that I understand the process of Assembling, the plan for reconstructing our lawful government, and my role as an assembly member, as well as the role of the Federation, The United States of America unincorporated.
